Innerwheel Club shimla golden bond team 2025-26 had a talk on cervical cancer by Dr. Himang Jharaik, MS OBG, Fellowship in Gynaecology Laparoscopy, Fellowship in basic Infertility. Medical Officer Specialist posted at DDU ZH (Ripon).

He said during the talk that, "Globally, cervical cancer is the fourth most common cancer in women, with around 660 000 new cases in 2022. In the same year, about 94% of the 350 000 deaths caused by cervical cancer occurred in low- and middle-income countries. The highest rates of cervical cancer incidence and mortality are in sub-Saharan Africa (SSA), Central America and South-East Asia. Regional differences in the cervical cancer burden are related to inequalities in access to vaccination, screening and treatment services, risk factors including HIV prevalence, and social and economic determinants such as sex, gender biases and poverty. Women living with HIV are 6 times more likely to develop cervical cancer compared to the general population, and an estimated 5% of all cervical cancer cases are attributable to HIV. Cervical cancer disproportionately affects younger women, and as a result, 20% of children who lose their mother to cancer do so due to cervical cancer." The talk ended by question-and-answer round. President Nirupma Chaudhary ji. Secretary Mrs. Vandana Sood, executive member Mrs. Meenakshi Sood and Innerwheel Member Dr. Anita Sood thanked Dr. Himang Jharaik by memento of appreciation.

VOCATIONAL CENTRE HISTORY

The place where the Inner Wheel Club of Shimla is running the Vocational Center was actually a dispensary. It was opened with a purpose to treat and help the less privileged people who couldn't afford the medicines. Rotary Club along with Inner Wheel, used to run the project with the help of their respective doctors but due to some reasons, the decision was taken to close it.

As we had such a huge n central place in the heart of the city, our club decided to open the Vocational Center for stitching here. It was started in the year 1984 .at that time we had only two machines and a teacher to start with. Very soon the Center started getting a response from the girls. Gradually it increased the number of the students and with the tremendous hard work of the teachers and the members it became popular. After a few years the girls showed their interest for Beautician course and seeing the demand, the club decided to open it with a classified teacher, which was a great success.

I am very proud to say that at present we are training almost 250 students and making them independent, contributing in women's empowerment.
